Critter Cabana is an exciting place to volunteer in large part because of the wide variety of animals that require handling and care. Although Critter Cabana staff will always try to keep each volunteer out of harm's way animals can often be unpredictable. Critter Cabana is in no way responsible for any injuries or health problems that may occur before, during or after your child's volunteer shift. Critter Cabana is also not responsible for any medical visits or bills that may arise from any injury, health problem or infection that can occur from animal bites, contact with animal feces, or the general handling of a sick or infected animal. This includes but is not limited to Salmonella, which can be transferred from any egg bearing animal. Proper hygiene should be practiced at all times to avoid such problems.

Critter Cabana can have a very hectic environment at times. Although Critter Cabana staff attempt to keep an eye on each volunteer it is ultimately impossible for staff to keep an eye on them at all times. Critter Cabana staff does not provide constant supervision or micro-manage volunteers. If you do not believe that your child is capable of making wise decisions when acting independently they are not an appropriate candidate for this position.
